## Week 1

### I can either do or complete these things

## Week 2

- Percussion: I can perform all numbers from the blue book (1.1 – 3.1) on both snare AND mallets

## Week 3

### I can either do or complete these things

- I can pass off a basic review with a 85% or better from Unit #1 - #3
- I can play my Concert Bb major scale and my chromatic Bb scale correctly with 4 or less mistakes
- I can play from my BLUE BOOK #3.1 – 3.25
- I can count, identify notes, semi-sing the 1<sup>st</sup> of my concert pieces for the Veteran's Day performance
- Percussion: I can count, name my notes, and understand my part for my 1<sup>st</sup> concert piece

## Week 4

### I can either do or complete these things

- I can play from my BLUE BOOK #3.26 – 4.20 correctly and accurately
- I can, with help, write out all my major scales
- I can count/play all level 3 rhythms with 5 mistakes or less
- I can play my 1<sup>st</sup> concert piece for the Veteran's Day performance with 10 mistakes or less
- Percussion: I can play all basic rudiments learned last year and be able to play mallet parts with 5 mistakes or less

## Week 5

### I can either do or complete these things

- I can play from my BLUE BOOK #4.20 – 5.9 correctly and accurately
- I can play my Concert Bb, Concert F, and Concert C major scales at quarter – 60 bpm using my scale sheet
- I can play my 1<sup>st</sup> piece for the Veteran's Day performance with 5 mistakes or less
- Percussion: I can play all basic rudiments learned from chapters 4 – 5 and able to play the mallet parts



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## Week 6

### I can either do or complete these things

- I can play from my BLUE BOOK #5.10 – 5.16 correctly and accurately
- Count/Play all of Level 3 and be able to sight read level 2 items
- I can name all the notes, count, identify the symbols of “Army” and “Navy” from my music
- I can play my 1<sup>st</sup> concert piece correctly with minimal mistakes
- Percussion: I can play my 1<sup>st</sup> piece with minimal mistakes; I can play the notes/rhythms of Army and Navy with 10 or less mistakes.

- Count/Play all of Level 3 rhythms correctly
- I can play Army, Navy, and Marines correctly
- I can play my Bb, F, C, and G major scales with help from my scale sheet
- Percussion: I can Army, Navy, and Marines correctly

- Play all lines from my BLUE BOOK 5.21 – 5.24 correctly
- I can play my 1<sup>st</sup> concert piece with minimal mistakes and full dynamics and musicianship
- I can play Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force correctly
- I can play my Bb, F, C, and G major scales with help from my scale sheet with 5 mistakes or less
- Percussion: I can Army, Navy, Marines, and Air Force correctly

## Week 9

- Play all lines from my BLUE BOOK 5.25 – 5.30 correctly
- I can play my 1<sup>st</sup> concert piece with minimal mistakes and full dynamics and musicianship
- I can play Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, and Coast Guard correctly
- I can play my Bb, F, C, and G major scales with help from my scale sheet with 5 mistakes or less
- Percussion: I can Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force and Coast Guard correctly

## Week 10
